LOT 347

A George III silver Fiddle pattern caddy spoon with scallop shell bowl, London 1816 by Josiah Snatt, length 8.5cm, together with a small group of other silver items, including two Old English bead pattern tablespoons, each bowl later decorated with lily-of-the-valley, and a sugar sifter spoon, Sheffield 1908, total weight 228.1g.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

347. Caddy spoon - slightly misshapen handle and typical light surface scratches and wear. Very small tear/split to rim of bowl (approx 3mm long), but no significant damage or repairs.

Two tablespoons with later decoration - both with typical wear and surface scratches, but no significant damage or repairs. Good clear hallmarks.

Sifter spoon - good condition with only typical light surface scratches and wear. Good clear hallmarks.

Salt spoon - good condition, tiny dent to bowl, otherwise only typical minor surface scratches and wear.

Paperknife - good condition with only typical light surface scratches and wear. No significant damage or repairs.
