A George III silver nutmeg grater of ovoid form with reeded rims, unscrewing to reveal a pierced steel grate, London 1789 by Samuel Meriton II, length 4.5cm, together with a small group of silver cutlery, including a set of six cake forks, London 1934, cased, and a set of six coffee spoons, Sheffield 1924, cased, total silver weight 247.9g, and a small group of plated items, including a set of six fruit knives and forks with mother-of-pearl handles, cased.

Condition Report

353. Nutmeg grater - the case has numerous dents and is worn. Marks are visible to interior. Steel grate fits well.

Silver christening fork & spoon, cased - good condition, typical light surface scratches and wear.

Set of six silver coffee spoons - good condition, typical light surface scratches and wear.

6 silver pastry forks - good condition, typical light surface scratches and wear.

6 silver handled butter knives - good condition, typical light surface scratches and wear.

6 mother-of-pearl handled knives and forks - good condition.

All other items in generally good order with typical light wear and scratches.
