A gold mounted pendant mourning locket, first quarter of the 19th century, glazed to one side with a hairwork and textile view of a classical lady and cherub, the reverse with a glazed woven hairwork panel, unmarked, length 4.6cm.

Condition Report

501. The locket is generally in good condition. On the front a small section of mount has split and is beginning to lift away. Some general fading to the textile view. Minor scratching to the glass facet edge. Minor dents to the edges of the gold mount. Weight 14.5g.

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
