LOT 587

A gold and diamond three stone ring, claw set with a row of cushion cut diamonds between decorated shoulders, detailed 'C&H 18ct', weight 2g, ring size approx Q, with a case.

Estimate: £250 - £350

Condition Report

587. Central diamonds approx 3.5mm diameter, side diamonds slightly different in size, one approx 2.5mm diameter, the other slightly smaller.

Diamonds are bright, white and sparkly. Larger side diamond has had a significant knock to the girdle near one claw where it has chipped, as well as having a couple of chips to the table facet edges, noticeable under magnification. Smaller side diamonds has an internal fracture near to one claw. Central diamond has one or two black inclusions, noticeable under magnification.

The claws are beginning to show signs of wear. Some minor wear to the shank.
