A gold, ruby and opal five stone ring, claw set with three oval opals and two oval cut rubies mounted at intervals, unmarked, weight 2.4g, ring size approx M1/2.

Condition Report

751. Some variation to the play of colour to the opals. Central stone quite milky, side ones with more vibrancy in shades of purple/blue. One side opal has a fairly large flat surface chip to one side, noticeable without magnification. The other side opal has a small surface chip. General scratching otherwise. Rubies are well matched for colour but are fairly included stones. One ruby has a small chip to the table facet edge, both with a few scratches to the table.

Claws beginning to show signs of wear. Shank has been resized in the past. Band unmarked.
