A gold, ruby and seed pearl necklace, designed as a row of graduating flowerheads, set with rubies surrounded by seed pearls alternating with pairs of leaf motifs, mounted with seed pearls, the front with a multiple leaf drop, on a curb chain with an S-hook shaped clasp, unmarked, weight 38.8g, length 48cm, with a case.

Estimate: £1,700 - £1,900

Condition Report

645. All pearls and rubies present.

The rubies are generally well matched for colour, although one or two are of a darker colour saturation.

One or two pearls may be later replacements with a difference in lustre, with some general wear overall.

There is wear to the connecting rings which may need securing.

Overall the piece is in generally good condition.
