A mid-19th century gold and banded agate mourning ring, detailed 'John Irving Esq' M.P. Ob Nov 10th 1845 Aet 77 yrs', the front mounted with a shield shaped banded agate, the shank further set with panels of banded agate, weight 7.8g, ring size approx P, with a case.

Condition Report

620. The central shield shaped agate has a few chips to the facet edges. Four or five of the agates to the shank have larger chips to the edges and/or table. The inscriptions still fairly crisp to the interior and there is a maker's mark for J.L. General scratching and a few minor dents to the band, but generally in good condition. The case is an association.
