### LOT 764

A silver stamp case, designed as an envelope, with engraved decoration, Birmingham 1911, width 3.2cm, a silver brooch, detailed 'Phyllis', and a late Victorian silver 'Mizpah' brooch, Birmingham 1888, total weight 10.3g, together with a single row necklace of imitation pearls, a Chinese character link bracelet and seven further brooches and badges, some relating to the First World War.

Estimate: £60 - £80

### Condition Report

764. Chinese character bracelet - 8.6g. One connecting link broken and missing. Clasp in good working order. General tarnishing to the link panel.

Stamp case - lightly bent in at the back.

Mizpah brooch - repair to hinge pin.

Pearls - discoloured, not individually knotted, some chips around holes.

Long butterfly wing brooch - butterfly wing extremely faded. Scratches to glass.

Ypres brooch - worn to engraved text 'Ypres' and to the beaded border.

Limoge porcelain oval brooch - moulding flaw to small area of surround.

Other pieces generally in good condition.

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
