A George III walnut cased bracket timepiece with eight day single fusee movement, the brass 4½-inch breakarch dial with silvered chapter ring, black Roman hour numerals and outer Arabic minutes, framing a matt centre with mock pendulum aperture and date aperture, cornered with gilt crown spandrels beneath a silvered oval boss to arch, inscribed 'Conyer Dunlop London', flanked by a pair of gilt putti, the case with a bell top above a moulded pediment and glazed door, on bracket feet, height 34.5cm, with pendulum.

Condition Report

1137. Good overall condition. The clock is working but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. The case has been restored. There is a chip to the moulded pediment. Part of the front bracket foot is missing on left side as well as some of the finish has come away (sellotape). Two marks to the front of the case. Some paint wear to the Arabic and Roman numerals.

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
