## LOT 1180

A George III oak longcase clock with eight day movement striking hours on a bell, the silvered breakarch dial with strike/silent indicator to arch above Roman hour numerals, subsidiary seconds and date dials and inscribed 'G. Hatch St. Albans', the hood with moulded arch pediment, glazed door and turned columns, the trunk with rectangular door, on a plain base and plinth, height 205cm, with pendulum, two weights and winder (some faults and alterations). Note: George Hatch is a recorded clockmaker working in St. Albans, Hertfordshire, circa 1800.

## Condition Report

1180. The clock has not been run recently.

There is a dent/crease to the dial at 11 o'clock, some paint damage to the numerals, the hood is cracked across the top and the moulded pediment. New hinges to trunk door. Splits to the front and sides of the base. The plinth is a later addition.
