## LOT 1023

A gold and enamelled cased keywind open-faced lady's pendant fob watch with unsigned gilt lever movement, the foliate engraved gilt dial with black Roman hour numerals, the enamelled case back painted with a flower spray within blue and gold scroll borders, gold inner case, the case back interior detailed '18k JPC', case diameter 2.8cm, fitted with a gold, diamond, half pearl and enamelled pendant brooch with crown surmount above enamelled rose, shamrock and thistle, length 2.6cm, total weight 20.8g.
