A Rolex Oyster Perpetual Chronometer steel and rose gold bubble-back cased gentleman's wristwatch, circa 1950s, Model No. 3372, the signed jewelled 645 caliber movement numbered '95143', the gloss black dial with luminous Arabic numerals and baton hour markers and signed 'Rolex Oyster Perpetual Chronomètre', the case with fixed rose gold bezel and milled bubble-back, the winding button detailed 'Rolex Oyster', the signed case interior numbered '3372', case width 3.2cm, on a black leather strap with 18ct rose gold Rolex buckle, detailed '750', total length 22.5cm.

Condition Report

1030. Serviced by the vendor in January 2021 where the glass was replaced and the numerals and markers were re-lumed. Otherwise the watch appears in good clean condition with no damage or repairs. The dial is nice and clean. Case has typical light surface scratches but nothing of any consequence. There are no serial numbers between lugs, possibly worn away. The watch winds and adjusts smoothly and is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

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
