A Glycine Airman Automatic stainless steel cased pilot's wristwatch, circa 1967, Serial No. 914974, the signed black dial with twenty-four hour Arabic chapter ring, centre seconds and date aperture, the circular EPSA compressor case with crosshatched crown and twenty-four hour rotating bezel for second time zone, which can be locked by secondary crown, the case back detailed 'Pat. 314050' above '914974', case diameter 3.6cm, on a Fixoflex stainless steel expanding bracelet.
