LOT 1123

An early 20th century mahogany circular cased wall timepiece with eight day fusee movement, the repainted circular 12-inch dial with black Roman hour numerals, the case with moulded surround, diameter 36.5cm, with pendulum and winding key.

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

1123. The case itself is in generally good order, with typical surface scuffs and knocks. Split to the circular surround at just above 9 o'clock. Splits to veneer on bow at bottom of case. Later knob attached to door in base of case.

The dial has been repainted. Hinge of front has had a lead repair.

The movement winds smoothly, but the pendulum is missing the hanging hook/pin to the top of the suspension spring, so not able to attach the pendulum and therefore cannot tell whether it is running.

However, all seems to be present and there does not seem to be any obvious reasons why it would not run after a clean.

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
