A large late 19th century French slate and green marble mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the two piece enamel dial with Roman hour numerals and visible Brocot escapement, the drum case flanked by a pair of scroll supports, on a plinth base with shaped apron, height 41cm, length 75cm, with pendulum.

Condition Report

1139. The clock is in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. There are some minor chips and scuffs to edges of the slate particularly around the apron and base edges. The two-piece enamel dial is in good order. The movement winds smoothly and runs, striking mechanism also working, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.
