An early 20th century circular mahogany cased wall timepiece with brass four pillar fusee movement, the circular painted 12-inch dial with black Roman hour numerals and inscribed 'W. Whittle 70 Marylebone Lane Wigmore St W', the moulded circular surround with cast brass bezel and bevelled glass, diameter 37.5cm, with pendulum, winding key and case key. Note: William Whittle is recorded as a watchmaker at 70 Marylebone Lane in the London street directory of 1921.

Condition Report

1128. Generally good condition. Typical wear and scuffs to case, but no significant damage. There are repaired splits on the surround at 9 o'clock and 10 o'clock. Cast bezel and hinge are good. The painted dial has some craquelure and a few small marks, but is otherwise ok.

The movement winds smoothly and it is currently in working order, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

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
