A rare mid-20th century Danish polished steel and black leather 'Scimitar' chair, model number IS-63, circa 1963, designed by Preben Fabricius and Jørgen Kastholm, and manufactured by Ivan Schlechter, bearing embossed manufacturer's logo to underside of leather and stamped to base 'Stainless Steel Denmark', height 64.5cm, width 82cm, depth 63cm.

Estimate: £1,500 - £2,500

Condition Report

2102. The leather has some light surface paint from clumsy near-by decorating, otherwise some overall light surface wear to leather with some light scuffs to edges and marks to seat. Leather all intact and no hardening of foam.

The frame has some very minor knocks to edges and some remnants of black polish which must have been used to re-colour the leather at some stage. The metal bolt heads on the underframe have a very light surface rust.

All parts appear to be original.
