An impressive set of four Regency mahogany shell back hall chairs, in the manner of Gillows of Lancaster, the crisply carved scallop shell backs above solid seat panels, raised on beaded and ring turned tapering legs, height 85cm, width 41cm, depth 49cm.

## **Condition Report**

2184. All four chairs have overall typical minor scuffs and scratches and one has an area of splashed watermarks to part of seat and back. All have some old historic scattered woodworm to seat rails and some overall light surface scuffs and wear to legs. One chair has a small crack to one rear leg and a re-spliced repair to top of other rear leg. One chair has thin crack to rear edge of seat rail and two repaired cracks to the top joints of both rear legs. Generally with the repairs and minor faults the chairs are still very presentable and still structurally sound.
