A group of First World War related crested china, mostly aeroplanes, including a Carlton China biplane, a similar Willow Art China example, a Grafton China aeroplane, an Arcadian China aeroplane, a Zeppelin modelled on the one destroyed by Lieutenant Robinson, two field guns and an Arcadian model of a French dagger (faults and restoration).
