An early 20th century Continental parasol with a silver and partly enamelled handle, the cream silk canopy removable with cover, length 102cm (faults).

Condition Report

2546. The silver handle has a few small dents to edge of the pommel. As can be seen in the images, there is a lilac enamelled band and we believe the rest of the silver pommel would have also originally been enamelled and quite possibly the shaft as well. The cream silk canopy opens up, there are a few splits and some light staining. The silk cover is badly damaged.

There is an Austro-Hungarian hallmark to the pommel, as well as another Austro-Hungarian hallmark and '950' to the base collar of the shaft.
