A Bohemian ruby flashed, cut glass and engraved goblet and cover, late 19th century, the flared bowl engraved with a gentleman in a rocky landscape within a ruby panel, raised on a waisted octagonal stem and spreading circular foot, the domed cover with ruby line and geometric detail, height 36.5cm.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

1702. The goblet is in good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear commensurate with age. No chips or cracks.

The cover appears to be in good condition but it is possible the tip of the finial has been broken and then been star-cut to disguise the damage. Otherwise no other damage or repairs.
