A Wedgwood crimson dip jasperware vase, early 20th century, ornamented in white with classical figures, height 15.2cm, and a Wedgwood blue dip jasperware mantel clock case, height 15cm, each with impressed marks (clock lacking movement).

## **Condition Report**

1649. Crimson dip vase - good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs. Some typical minor scuffs and scratches to crimson ground. The lady holding Achilles by the ankle has a small chip to her left shoulder and elbow, on the back of the ornamentation.

Blue dip clock case - generally good condition, but with minor chips around circular aperture rim and few minor chips to base edge. Some firing cracks visible to white foliate ornamentation around base and figures. Typical light scuffs and scratches.
