A small group of pottery by Robert Garnet Heal, comprising an hexagonal vase with incised decoration in Martin Brothers style, height 20.5cm, a pair of lampbases with twisted handles, height 19cm, a vase with foliate decoration and a bowl with an incised floral medallion, each with incised 'RGH' mark to base. Note: Robert Garnet Heal was Ambrose Heal's cousin, with whom he became co-director of the famous family firm Heal's. These pottery items were originally part of a selling exhibition held at The Millinery Works, Islington, London.

Condition Report

1606. Hexagonal vase - good condition with no significant damage or repairs. However, there are some glaze blemishes to side panels and edges which have occurred in the firing process where glaze bubbles have 'popped' leaving some unglazed patches/marks.

All other pieces in good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs.
