A mixed group of decorative ceramics, 19th century and later, including a Sunderland lustre pearlware jug, decorated with titled scene 'Sailors' Farewell', height 15.5cm, a pair of Minton cabinet plates, each painted with a floral spray within a pale blue and gilt Greek key border, diameter 23cm, a pair of leaf shaped dishes, painted with exotic birds, length 19.6cm, and a Royal Crown Derby robin paperweight (lacking stopper).

Condition Report

1687. Pearlware jug - heavily crazed, typical wear to the lustre on high points, some scratching to one side.
Meissen style miniature cup & saucer - chips to base of saucer.
Crown Derby robin - lacking stopper.
Miniature Imari cup & saucer - some staining.
Teapot - repaired handle, heavy wear.
Derby jug - hairline cracks.
Floral plate - crazed.
Green foliate rimmed cup & saucer - saucer cracked, crazing to both.
Pink printed bowls - both crazed and stained.
Exotic bird dish - both with chips to rim.
General wear to all items.
