A Minton jardinière, circa 1862, of U-shape with lion mask handles, painted with a river landscape view opposing a ship on a beach by crashing waves, above a low-bellied blue ground border with white reeded detail, impressed and painted marks to base, height 20.5cm (restored).

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

1497. There is a restored vertical crack which runs approx 9cm down from the rim. There has been some turquoise overpainting to the interior of this area, but crack is obviously visible to exterior. There is some minor paint loss where the landscape band meets the mustard yellow rim band, and a horizontal hairline on the corresponding area of turquoise interior. Two sections of footrim restored, one approx 4cm in length, the other 2.5cm long. There is also a line/area of limescale around the top 4cm of the rim interior. Typical crazing to glaze.
