An Art Deco Shelley Queen Anne shape Tall Trees & Sunset pattern part tea and coffee service, 1925-35, comprising coffee pot and cover, eleven coffee cups and twelve saucers, teapot, cover and stand, six teacups and eight saucers, milk jug, cream jug, two graduated sugar bowls, large serving bowl, rectangular tray, two cake plates, eleven breakfast bowls, twelve sandwich plates and ten side plates, printed marks and painted pattern number '11479' to bases (some faults).

Condition Report

1675. Teapot - the body has hairline cracks in a number of places beside base of spout and handle. Couple of small chips to interior rim.

Teapot stand - small hairline crack to underside of rim.

Cake plates - one crazed, the other badly cracked.

Breakfast bowls - two cracked, all with some discolouration/staining to the rim and fine crazing.

Side plates - six with hairline cracks, three ok, another crazed.

Sandwich plates - seven with hairline cracks, three crazed and stained, two ok, all have a level of discolouration/staining to rims.

Both sugar bowls - with hairline cracks.

Milk jug - some rubbing to handle decoration.

Teacups - two with hairline cracks, four ok, minor crazing.

Teacup saucers - three cracked, another crazed, four with some staining/wear to central decoration.

Coffee cups - one with broken handle, ten ok.

Coffee saucers - one crazed, one with small chip to rim, ten ok, minor rim discolouration/staining.

All other pieces ok, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Overall some typical light surface wear, particularly to high points and handles. Some very minor surface scratching generally to plates.
