A harlequin set of five Richard Batterham ash glazed studio pottery bowls with various impressed and cut decoration, unmarked, diameter 16cm, together with a similar larger bowl, diameter 30.8cm, a teapot and cover and a mixed group of other studio pottery, including a Diana Peyton celadon glazed bowl (minor chips).

Condition Report

1427. Batterham bowls - three bowls have small chips/nicks to the rim, the other two in good condition.

Teapot - tiny nicks to spout, otherwise ok.

Large bowl - in good condition.

Spherical vase/bowl - firing crack to rim.

Small footed wide rimmed bowl - minor nibbles to rim.

Pot and cover - the cover has a couple of chips to rim and chip to pot rim.

Large blue bowl - a few small chips to glaze on rim.

Other pieces in generally good condition.
