A Rockingham part tea service, circa 1830-42, with three-spur handles, pattern No. 1316, comprising teapot and cover, sucrier and cover, slop bowl, jug, twelve teacups, nine coffee cups, twelve saucers and two plates, puce printed factory mark to saucers (minor faults).

Condition Report

1509. Overall the service is in generally good condition with no significant damage and no repairs. Painting is good and vibrant. Typical light crazing and typical light wear to gilt and enamels, but nothing really significant. Some slight staining to glaze, more pronounced to interiors of teapot, sucrier and jug.

Sucrier has three chips to inner rim.

2 teacups with minor rim hairlines.

2 coffee cups have chips to rim, otherwise ok.

1 coffee cup has a repaired handle and cracked.

1 coffee cup has a hairline to base of handle, otherwise ok.

1 coffee cup has a wobbly foot, but otherwise ok.

1 coffee cup has a hairline to rim and hairline to handle, otherwise ok.

2 saucers with rim chips, 1 saucer with hairline to rim, otherwise ok.
