A pair of 'Sèvres' porcelain plates, 19th century, the bleu de roi ground rims overlaid with rococo scroll detail and reserved with three panels enclosing oval sepia classical portraits, flanked by enamelled flowers, a monogram formed from floral garlands to each well, unmarked, diameter 24.4cm.

## Condition Report

1455. Both plates are in similar condition with no significant damage. One has a 2mm firing crack to rim, but this is in the manufacture. The other has a tiny chip to the rim which has been re-touched. Both have wear/loss to gilt decoration and gilt bands. Typical surface scratches and wear to glaze.
