A slipware pottery baking dish, 19th century, possibly Buckley, with looped, dotted, wavy line and dash decoration, length 31cm, together with two divided slipware dishes and a 20th century studio pottery rectangular slipware dish, decorated with two hares beneath a tree, length 30cm (some faults and repairs).

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1590. Light brown and cream shallow dish - numerous small chips to rim. Wear and scratches to interior and some light crazing. There is also a crack visible in the middle of the dish (approx 12cm long), but it is not visible to the underside.

Rectangular 'tree' dish - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Darker two-section dish - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical surface scratches and wear to glaze.

Lighter dish - crack running from rim into the dish across one corner, crack approx 20cm long and chips along the crack line. Minor rim chips and minor chips to slip. Surface scratches and wear.
