Two Copeland Parian Crystal Palace Art Union busts, second half 19th century, the first depicting Shakespeare, sculpted by R. Monti, height 34.5cm, the second Sir Walter Scott, height 35cm, both with impressed marks.

Condition Report

1448. Shakespeare - a number of chips and nibbles to the base where it joins the main body. A small chip to the underside of the base. Otherwise in generally good condition.

Walter Scott - a couple of tiny nibbles to the base rim. A small dark firing crack to the back, approx 1cm in length. When tipped you can hear that there is something loose within the body, most likely a piece of the old padding which is visible between the base and body. Otherwise in generally good condition.
