A late 19th century Paris porcelain Sèvres style bleu céleste ground mantel clock of rectangular shape, painted with a panel of Cupid beneath the gilt metal chapter ring and white enamel dial, inscribed 'HRY Marc a Paris', the rest of the body with floral panels and borders within gilt framing, the eight day movement striking on a bell, height 23.7cm, with pendulum and winding key (lacking surmount).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1647. The case is missing its surmount. The porcelain is otherwise in generally good condition with a few minor chips and wear to gilt and enamels. Enamel dial has some hairline cracks. It does not currently run so some attention needed with movement. Key and pendulum present. 16.7cm at widest point.

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
