A pair of Edwardian silver twin-branch three-light candelabra, each foliate scroll branch with urn shaped sconce, on a foliate scroll moulded tapering stem and base, Sheffield 1902 by Walker & Hall, height 53cm.

Estimate: £1,200 - £1,800

Condition Report

350. Both are fairly dirty with some uneven discolouration and would benefit greatly from a clean.

Candelabra 1 - generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs, but typical surface scratches and wear. Central sconce slightly bent to one side and all three sconces have drilled holes to the underside where they must have been fitted for electricity. Base of stick with engraved monogram and small inscription. Good clear hallmarks.

Candelabra 2 - generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs, typical scratches and surface wear. Central sconce slightly bent. One drip tray has started to become detached along the seam where the relief moulded upper section meets the plain flat underside. All three sconces have been drilled for electricity, as with the other candelabra. Base of stick with engraved monogram and small inscription. Good clear hallmarks.

Total weight, including filled bases 4970g. Weight of branches only 2531g.
