A pair of enameled glass decanters and stoppers, 19th century, in Beilby style, each flattened bulbous body enameled to each side in blue and white with a ship above the inscription 'Nelson', within scroll and trellis framing, the extended cylindrical neck with dot and line detail beneath scalloped disc stoppers, height 44cm.

## Condition Report

1747. Both appear to be in generally good condition, however one has a small diagonal blemish/crack to its neck (approx 4cm long) starting just below the outswep neck rim. Otherwise only typical light surface wear to enamels, but no other significant damage or repairs. One stopper has a small chip to the lower terminal.
