A pair of Charles II silver lace-back trefid spoons, each bowl back with ribbed rat tail and foliate scroll decoration, each terminal with similar decoration, London 1678 by Robert King, total weight 88.1g, length 18.5cm.

Condition Report

430. Both in generally good condition with no significant damage. No repairs, but both have typical wear commensurate with age, meaning the highpoints to the lace decoration front and back is worn and has lost the sharpness to the detail. Both with typical surface scratches. One with slight wear and a small nick to rim of bowl. The other with slight wear to bowl rim. Hallmarks to stem backs are good and clear.
