A Meissen Onion pattern pierced porcelain part dessert service, late 19th/early 20th century, painted in underglaze blue with gilt details, comprising twelve plates and two comports with knopped stems and spreading circular feet, crossed swords in underglaze blue, painted and impressed numerals to base, diameter of plates 20.5cm, height of comports 22cm (one comport restored).

Condition Report

1540. 1 comport has restoration to two sections of the rim and two of the floral panels. All the other pieces are in good condition with no chips, cracks, restoration or staining. There is some typical, but very light, wear to gilt, but nothing of any real significance. Minor scratches to glaze.
