### Condition Report

1481. 4 Crown Derby plates - all in good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs. 2 of them with slightly more wear to inner gilt band. Typical light surface scratches and wear to painting. Gilt otherwise in good crisp order.

3 Copeland plates - 2 in good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs. 1 with small hairline (2cm long), otherwise same minor wear and surface scratches.
