A Victorian gold backed and silver fronted diamond brooch, designed as a foliate spray, mounted with cushion cut diamonds, unmarked, weight 8.5g, width 4.4cm, with an associated case.

Condition Report

525. There is some variation of cut to the diamonds. The diamonds in general slightly draw colour and most have a few internal inclusions. The roller clasp is a later replacement. There is a small crack at the back of one of the leaf motifs near to the centre of the brooch.

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
