### LOT 545

A late Victorian gold backed and silver set peridot and diamond brooch, claw set with the octagonal step cut peridot within a scroll pierced surround, set with cushion and rose cut diamonds, weight 5.6g, width 2.5cm, with a case.

Estimate: £400 - £600

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### Condition Report

545. The peridot is of medium colour saturation and is in good condition. Peridot size approx.  $\blacklozenge$  1.25cm x 1.1cm. One claw to one corner of the peridot is not properly connecting, some of the other claws are beginning to show signs of wear. The diamonds look to be attractive white stones, with one or two tiny inclusions. The silver setting is rather tarnished. The original screw-in fitting is lacking when it would have been worn as a brooch. The current brooch fitting is a replacement. The pendant suspension loop by the rollover clasp to hold the pin has been removed, it is now not possible to interchange between brooch and pendant wear.

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
