A Victorian 18ct gold, black enamelled and seed pearl mourning ring, designed as a forget-me-knot spray within an oval surround between floral decorated black enamelled shoulders, detailed 'My Father J Hockley Obt Jany 15th 1867', London 1866, weight 2.5g, ring size approx K, with a case.

Condition Report

720. The seed pearls are in good condition, if a little dirty. There is quite a bad chip towards the bottom of the enamel. There are other lesser chips and surface nicks. The shoulders both have damage to the black enamel. One shoulder has a hallmark date letter for London 1866. The glazing and frame to the locket at the back is missing. Hallmark clear, inscription clear. The case is in good condition.

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
