An early Victorian rose cut diamond oval mourning brooch, circa 1850, the centre with an applied forget-me-knot spray motif on a black ground, width 2.9cm.

Estimate: £180 - £220

Condition Report

725. The rose diamonds slightly draw colour and have a few internal inclusions. Some variation of cut to the rose diamonds. Black surround in good condition, we are unsure if it is black onyx or enamel. There is a split along the edge behind the hinge connecting the back panel to the front of the brooch. This back panel was probably applied with lead solder and may be a replacement from the original construction of the piece.
