A gold and turquoise heart shaped pendant locket, circa 1910-20, weight 3.5g, length 2cm, with a later 14ct gold neckchain on a boltring clasp, detailed '750', weight 1.6g, length 44.5cm.

Condition Report

742. The plastic covering to the photograph of the locket is cracked. The hinge is in fairly good condition. The front of the heart is in good condition. The turquoise has a few minor surface marks but looks to be in otherwise good original natural condition. The back of the heart has one or two tiny dents to the side. There are no marks to the heart, which has not been tested by us. The gold is of a light rose gold appearance. The later modern neckchain is import hallmarked 14ct gold, the boltring is detailed **◆750◆** and is possibly replaced.

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
