### LOT 751

A 19th century gold and pale blue enamel ring, the front with an applied rose cut diamond set forget-me-not stem on a shaped oval pale blue enamelled ground, weight 3.9g, ring size approx N1/2.

Estimate: £100 - £150

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### Condition Report

751. Some damage to the forget-me-knot spray, one rose diamond lacking. The foliate motifs are lacking. The flowerhead central gem is perhaps a paste replacement. Some wear and chips to the enamelled shoulders. The under bezel glazing and frame is lacking. Lead solder join repair to the back of the shank. Some loss of detail to the inscription within the shank, 'Matilda Chandler... 12 Oct 32yrs'.  
No hallmarks.

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
