### LOT 776

A small group of jewellery, including a colourless paste swallow brooch, detailed 'silver', weight 9.8g, width 4.1cm, a silver, gilt and colourless paste pendant brooch, designed as a Maltese cross, unmarked, weight 13.2g, length 4.8cm (the centre paste detached but present), and a dress Albertine, fitted with a T-bar, tassel and swivel, detailed 'solid silver'.

Estimate: £50 - £70

### Condition Report

776. Swallow brooch - lacking a colourless paste from the head, some variation of colour to the remaining pastes.

Maltese cross - central colourless paste detached but present, one or two pastes probably replaced in the past, pin slightly bent.

Pair of bird brooches (gilt) - both have a casting flaw to one wing.

Stud with scarab - fitting to back is bent.

Pale blue gem drop - minor nibbles to gemstones.

Bar brooch - heavily rubbed, gilding now down to base metal in a number of places.

Heart case - some general wear to case exterior.

Albertine - heart with split to base. Split to one oval link where originally joined, slightly bent.

Other pieces in generally good condition.
