### LOT 662

A silver mounted varicoloured granite oval brooch, probably Scottish, unmarked, width 6cm, a silver and marcasite brooch, a late Victorian silver brooch with a bird motif, Birmingham 1899, a cameo pendant brooch, designed as a flower, a lava cameo bracelet, a French bracelet, a silver pendant cross with a neckchain, a pair of imitation pearl earrings and a marcasite pendant.

Estimate: £80 - £120

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### Condition Report

662. Granite brooch - pin bent and one side of rim slightly bent.

Lava cameo bracelet - one cameo has a chip to one side, another has a small crack, generally all have some wear.

Bird bar brooch - slightly bent tail to bird.

Foliage drop - lacking one shell nearest suspension loop. Evidence of re-gluing to others.

Bracelet - lacking clasp/fastenings at both ends.

Imitation pearl earrings - minor wear to the pearls. Both hook fittings are probably later fitted, both easily detach from the rest of the earring.

Other pieces with general surface wear, but in generally good condition.

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
