A late Victorian gold backed and silver set, diamond and varicoloured cultured pearl pendant brooch, circa 1890, designed as a vine leaf, mounted with varicoloured cultured pearls within a surround of cushion and rose cut diamonds, unmarked, weight 18.9g, width 6cm.

Condition Report

733. Would benefit from a professional clean. Pearls have a good lustre and appear to be in generally good condition. One or two diamonds are chipped. Diamonds have one or two internal inclusions noticeable under magnification. The suspension loop is potentially a later addition.

Length excluding suspension loop approx 6cm, including suspension loop approx 6.6cm, width approx 5.1cm

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
