A platinum ring, claw set with a cushion cut ruby between two cushion cut diamonds in square shaped settings, London 1978, weight 4.6g, ring size approx P, fitted with two sizing beads, with a case.

Condition Report

551. The ruby has a small chip to the side of the table facet, noticeable without magnification. It also has one or two nicks to the girdle and table facet edge.

The ruby has a slightly cloudy appearance to the table, with a few internal inclusions evident.

The side diamonds have one or two internal inclusions but appear to be quite white stones.

The ring otherwise in generally good condition.
