A pair of Victorian gold pendant earrings, each with a foliate capped acorn to the centre within an oval surround, with wire fittings, unmarked, weight 2g, length 3cm.

Condition Report

739. The earrings have probably been gilt flashed and are now showing signs of tarnish/discolouration. One acorn has a small dent to the back top half. The other acorn has a small dent to the front on the bottom half, as well as a couple more to the back. The same earring has some heavy wear to the surmount where it is joined to the drop. It's hook fitting is also misshaped compared to the other earring.
