An 18ct gold, opal and diamond ring, mounted with five oval opals graduating in size to the centre, otherwise set with eight cushion cut diamonds at intervals, with scroll pierced sides, London 1967, weight 5.9g, ring size approx P.

Estimate: £650 - £850

Condition Report

585. The opals generally have a good play of colour, in shades of red, green and blue. The central opal has a large flat chip to one side and a smaller flat chip to an edge near to one claw. The other opals have general surface wear, with one or two tiny nicks. There is some wear to the claws which require re-tipping. The diamonds have a few internal inclusions. The ring would benefit from a professional clean.

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
