### LOT 616

A Victorian 12ct gold, turquoise and garnet three stone ring, mounted with three oval turquoises alternating with two oval cut garnets, London 1858, weight 1.4g, ring size approx L, with a case.

Estimate: £80 - £120

### Condition Report

616. Two of the three turquoise are noticeably discoloured, the third one has a chip to one side.

One garnet is quite heavily included, the other has one or two inclusions, with a few surface nicks and scratches to facet.

Some wear to the claws which will need re-tipping. Some tarnish/discolouration to the metal. The shank has thinned at the back. On one side of the mount a portion of the decoration appears to be lacking, possibly worn away through rubbing against another ring.
